With regard to those claimants who are being paid benefits from the Special Fund, this Office will send the LS-200 to them for completion and return to our district offices. Copies of those forms which are returned and which show earnings from employment will also be sent to the insurance carriers or self-insured employers who originally paid benefits in the cases. This Office will attempt to modify any outstanding awards in those cases in

which it appears that an adjustment in compensation benefits is indicated based on the earnings information that has been furnished and other information contained in the case files. However, insurance carriers or self-insured employers who initially paid benefits in the cases may participate in these modification proceedings or they may initiate actions of their own if this Office decides not to pursue the matter.
