The EEOICPA provides lump-sum compensation and medical benefits to current and former nuclear weapons workers whose illness is a result of working in the nuclear weapons industry. Survivors of qualified workers may also be entitled to benefits.

Covered illnesses include but are not limited to radiation-induced cancer, chronic beryllium disease, beryllium sensitivity, chronic silicosis, or any illness due to exposure to toxic substances.

Representatives from the Department of Labor (DOL) and the Resource Center will be available to assist with claim filing, claim status, and answer questions.



Current and former employees of the Kansas City Plant or any facility involved in nuclear weapons production who are in need of assistance are encouraged to attend!
