2. Board Request: Toxic substances that are found to be probable human carcinogens (International Agency for Research on Cancer - IARC Group 2A) and that have limited human epidemiological evidence for specific human cancer sites as identified in table 1, should be linked to those cancer sites in the [SEM].

## DOL Response: The Department agrees to add health effect data to SEM that links the identified (Table 1) cancers to the noted toxic substances.

Follow Up: DOL is proceeding with adding the recommended health effect data to SEM. However, a question has arisen on one cancer description from Table 1 that the Board needs to review and provide input:
