## Tools & Resources

The DEEOIC website has all the information, tools, and resources you need to make the claims process easier! The website is your guide to everything you need to know about the DEEOIC.

### The website contains:

**How-to-Guides** - Our How-to-Guides present information regarding eligibility and how to file a claim for benefits, check your claim status, file claims for impairment and wage loss, file for consequential illnesses, request home health care, and access your claim and medical portal.

**Energy Document Portal (EDP)** - Use the EDP to upload documents directly to your case file. The Portal provides safe and secure document transmission. Information is submitted instantly, eliminating mailing delays.

**Federal (EEOICPA) Procedure Manual (PM)** - The PM provides guidance to claims staff about DEEOIC Policies and Procedures, the process of collecting and evaluating evidence, the decision-making process, and how claims for compensation and medical benefits are processed.

**EEOICPA Bulletins and Circulars** - EEOICPA Bulletins provide further guidance to claims staff on handling of new claim situations not addressed in the PM. EEOICPA Circulars communicate items of informational value.

**Updates via Email** - Register your email address to receive updates about DEEOIC policies and procedures and/or medical bill pay topics. Look for "Subscribe To" on our main website page.

**DOE Facility List** - The Department of Energy (DOE) maintains a database of facilities covered under the EEOICPA. Here, you can search for a facility by name/state/location/keyword, read the facility description, and view the covered time periods.

**BTComp Subcontractor Database** - The BTComp database provides a listing of contractors and subcontractors with a known contractual relationship with various DOE facilities covered under the program.

**Site Exposure Matrices (SEM)** - The SEM provides information about buildings, labor categories, and work processes at DOE sites and RECA facilities. In addition to toxic substance information, the SEM contains information regarding scientifically established links between substances and illnesses.

**NIOSH Dose Reconstruction Topics** - Access the National Institute for Occupational Safety & Health (NIOSH) website to find out more about radiation dose reconstruction, probability of causation, work sites with classes in the Special Exposure Cohort (SEC), and residual contamination.

**Medical Bill Portal** - Access the medical bill portal to find our medical benefits brochure, overview of the Medical Benefits Identification Card, provider search, medical bill status, and instructions for medical reimbursement through Electronic Funds Transfer.

**Claimant Status** - View a snapshot of your claim. See the claimed conditions, worksite locations, recent claims action, and payment information.

**Statistics** - View data regarding the number of applications filed, as well as total compensation and medical benefits paid. You can also find data by State or Facility and Part B/E totals.

**Brochures** - Learn about the program by reading various brochures. These include Eligibility, Home Health Care Services, Impairment Qualifications, Medical Benefits, How Claims are Processed, and more!
