This memorandum is in regard to the findings for the Accountability Review (AR) that was conducted in the Denver District Office in July 2014. Attached are the final versions of the accountability review findings, to include a summary sheet and final AR-1 documents.

Additionally, we have also taken the time to respond to your comments and objections submitted on August 1, 2014. We have taken your comments into consideration and have incorporated a few changes in our findings. After incorporating these changes, the final rating for Category 2, Part E Causation was raised from 85% to 86%, and the rating for Category 6, In-Home Health Care was raised from 94% to 95%.

Because each category met or exceeded the acceptability rating, no corrective action report (AR-10) is necessary. Congratulations to the Denver District office for your excellent work. This memorandum is for your records and informational purposes regarding the Denver District Office Accountability Review (AR) conducted July 21-25, 2014. Attached are copies of the final reports, which include the Weighted Accountability Review Findings (AR-1), Overall Summary Report, Full Indicator Summary Scoresheet Report, and Indicator Remarks by Case, Case Comments.

The findings from the AR show that the Denver District office met or exceeded the acceptable rating of 85% in each of the Categories for which they were rated. The final ratings for the Categories are as follows:

Category 1 – Part B Claims – 92%

Category 2 – Part E Causation – 86%

Category 3 – Impairment Claims – 95%

Category 4 – Wage Loss Claims – 90%

Category 5 – Payment Processing – 99%

Category 6 – In-Home Health Care Requests – 95%
