

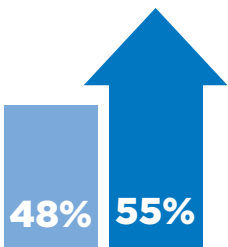

## Jobs for Veterans State Grants (JVSG)



From FY 2009 to FY 2013, the percentage of participants entering employment after exit from the program has **increased from 48% to 55%**.

# 80%

Of those who entered employment in FY 2013, **80%** retain employment after six months. This is up from 74% in PY 2009.

The program has more than doubled the rate of intensive services to veterans, from 22% in PY 2009 to **more than 55% as of the end of PY 2013** (June 30, 2014).

## Transition Assistance Program (TAP)

# 6,697

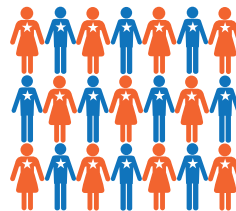
The number of Department of Labor employment workshops conducted has increased to 6,697 in FY 2014 as a result of the VOW Act requirement for mandatory participation in the TAP program.

TAP participation has **increased by 60%** since FY 2010, with over 200,000 participants in FY 2014.

## Homeless Veterans' Reintegration Program (HVRP)



The program continues to provide comprehensive employment services to over **16,000** homeless veterans annually



The placement rate of homeless veterans **has risen** from 59% in PY 2009 to **63% in PY 2013**.

Average hourly wages of participants **have increased 10%** since PY 2009.
