
Making Progress

Education and the Pay Gap

Despite progress, gender wage gaps persist across all education levels.

Gender earnings ratios by comparable educational attainment.

Less than high school	80%
High school graduates, no college	78%
Some college or associate degree	76%
Bachelor's degree only	76%
Advanced degree	77%
